


MOPAC INTERSECTIONS ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY

PROPOSED BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ACCOMMODATIONS OVERVIEW

The MoPac Intersections Environmental Study proposes the construction of a new Shared Use Path (SUP) along the right-of-way line on the west side of the corridor in the vicinity of Slaughter Lane and La Crosse Avenue. The proposed SUP would tie-in to other proposed improvements along MoPac South and the existing city of Austin bicycle and pedestrian network.

This preliminary conceptual layout features one of the intersections included in the proposed MoPac Intersections project, MoPac at Slaughter Lane, and shows how the SUP would be constructed along the right-of-way line.
